Background

- Establish and maintain communication and network with our partners and stakeholders.
- Take part in CSF Indonesia organizational activities including proposal development and strategic planning.
- Take notes and minutes of meeting.
- Keep record of activity related documents such as reports, progress updates, photos, contacts, and written and unwritten communications.
- Take part in writing project reports, analysis, and writing of academic publications.
- Perform general program support.
